

REGULATION MUST BE ADHERED IN GUN-GALUUT NATURE RESERVE

1. Purpose of this regulation

1.1 Any activities and relations performed in the Gun-Galuut NR of Bayandelger suum, Tov province are regulated by Constitution of Mongolia, law on environmental protection, law on special protected area and this regulations based on these laws.

2. General Articles

2.1 Nature Reserve mean is area taken under the state special protection to protect certain type of nature, to protect and conserve any resources, and to facilitate reclamation.

2.2 Gun-Galuut NR is a locally protected area for purpose of developing tourism, protecting nationally and globally threatened biodiversity and its habitat.

2.3 To establish organization in charge of management and governance on NR an accordance with resolution of the Citizens Representative Khural of suum.

2.4 Citizens, business entities and organizations get permission from land relative organization for carrying out any activities except traditional cattle-raising in the NR.

2.5 Boundary and inner zoning of the NR are approved by the Citizens' Representative Khural of suum, which concerns the opinions of organization responsible for this NR and environmental certified organization.

3. Activities to be allowed in Nature Reserve

3.1 Activities allowed and prohibited in the core, tourism and limited zone of the NR are respectively different.

3.2 Apart from protection measures to carry out surveys and research with methods which do not have impacts on environment, to create conditions where flora and fauna will grow and reproduce, to reclaim soil and to mitigate the damages caused by natural disaster shall be taken in core zone.

3.3 Environmental certified organization carry out measures to regulate abundance of bio species and their growing an according to the decision of organization in charge of NR.

3.4 The following activities may be conducted with a relevant permission in a tourism zone in a manner that is not harmful to environment.

3.4.1 To conduct the activities 3.2, 3.3 provided in this regulation

3.4.2 To run tour in permitted place

3.4.3 To fish and organize sport-hunting in permitted place

3.4.4 To build facilities for tourism

3.4.5 Administrative body in charge of NR and tourism, and their staffs are permitted to stay there

3.5 The following activities may be conducted in limited zone.

- 3.5.1 To conduct the activities 3.2, 3.4 provided in this regulation.
- 3.5.2 To run animal husbandry in a traditional way, and to build facilities for livestock
- 3.5.3 To build roads and car parks according to approved projects, drawings and relevant procedures

4. Prohibited activities in Nature Reserve

- 4.1 The following activities shall be prohibited in the core, tourism and limited zone of NR for any purpose except those provided in 3.2; 3.2, 3.4 and 3.2, 3.4, 3.5 of this regulation respectively.
- 4.2 The following activities shall be prohibited in the NR for any purpose except those provided in 3.2, 3.4 and 3.5 of this regulation.
 - 4.2.1 To change the state of the nature by land ploughing, digging or exploding, wood, reed cutting, and road making in area other limited zone.
 - 4.2.2 To collect and prepare natural secondary resources, medicinal, food or technical plants for the production purposes.
 - 4.2.3 To hunt, catch, scare or drive out animals, damage or demolish their nests, dens or holes with the purpose other than activities regulating the census, of animals, their number, age, gender and herd composition.
 - 4.2.4 To use any method, technique or substance harmful to the nature and environment in the fight against harmful insects, rodents, fire and in the prevention thereof.
 - 4.2.5 To conduct any activities polluting water, soil or air
 - 4.2.6 To have a gun or a dog without permission from the administrative of area protection.
 - 4.2.7 To conduct facilities for winter, spring, autumn and summer camping site, and pasture cattle permanently in the care and tourism zone.
 - 4.2.8 To exploit open water sources such as rivers, lakes and springs for production purposes.
 - 4.2.9 To extend the territory of a village and build facilities breaching the approved general plan, project and drawings.
 - 4.2.10 To conduct other activities harmful to the nature and environment prohibited by legislation and protection regime.
 - 4.2.11 Fees and payments for using NR.

5. Fees and payment

- 5.1 The Citizens' Representative Khural approves the amount of payment of entering NR, and fees of using natural resources to meet legislation of Mongolia by concerning opinion of organization in charge of NR.
- 5.2 Organization in charge of NR and tourism companies approve the amount of fees and payment collected their operations established by themselves.
- 5.3 Entered foreign and domestic citizens pay for getting on vacation, taking journey, fishing and hunting in he NR.
- 5.4 To take payment from the means of transport entered for purpose provided in 5.3 of this regulation.

- 5.5 The citizen pay for driving out animals and hunting wolves in the limited zone of NR.
 - 5.6 The citizen pay fees set up by the Citizens' Representative Khural of soum for fishing in the tourism zone of the NR.
 - 5.7 The citizen entering with purpose of fishing and hunting in the NR, pay fees as well as payment provided in 5.3 of this regulation.
 - 5.8 Whoever entering the NR has duty to pay to ranger with the purpose provided in 5.3 of this regulation.
- 6. Liabilities to be imposed on violators of the legislation**
- 6.1 Penalties shall be imposed on violators of the legislation relevant usage and protection on NR by the state environmental inspector and ranger of NR an accordance with 1, 2 and 3 of article 43 of Mongolian law on special protected area.
 - 6.2 Penalties shall be imposed on violators of the legislation relevant usage and protection on natural resources plants, animals, water, soil and land of NR by the state environmental inspector and ranger on NR an accordance with selected law about natural resources of Mongolia.
 - 6.3 Administrative liabilities provided in the laws shall be imposed on persons, who violated the procedures, regimes and provisions approved in this regulation by the state environmental inspector, ranger of NR, supervision organization on legislation and administrative staffs.
